M. for the said Margaret Doll Jones to show cause, if any there be, why a committee or trustee should not be appointed to take charge of and manage the property of the said alleged incompetent, pending which time and at any time thereafter the said Margaret Doll Jones may appear and answer, the Court retaining the power to revoke, modify, or alter any decree hereunder at any time after appearance and answer for good cause shown.
