TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of Byron W. Thompson, Administrator, and J. Peter Frey and Grace I. Frey, his wife, respectfully shows:

FIRST: That on April 6, 1955, your Petitioners, as Administrator and one of the heirs of the Plaintiff, Lillian H. Shepley, filed a Petition reciting the death of the Plaintiff on October 22, 1954 and praying that the other heirs of the said Lillian H. Shepley be made parties to this proceeding for the sale of the real estate owned by the said Lillian H. Shepley at the time of her death.

SECOND: That on April 13, 1955, the Defendants Vaughn Beard and Mrs. Vaughn Beard were summoned; that on April 13, 1955, the Sheriff of Washington County summoned one Hazel Creager, who is one and the same person as the Defendant Hazel Miner, and who was discovered to be not married at the time of the summons; that the Defendants James Creager and Mrs. James Creager were summoned on April 14, 1955; that the Defendant Gail Beard was summoned on April 14, 1955; that the Defendants Barbara Warrenfeltz and Philip Warrenfeltz were summoned on April 20, 1955; that the Defendants Richard R. Frye and Minnie Frye, his wife, were summoned on April 16, 1955; and that said Defendants were summoned to appear and answer the Bill of Complaint and Petition filed in this cause on or before May 24, 1955, and have failed to do so.

THIRD: That on April 7, 1955, an order of publication was duly issued in this case by the Clerk of your Honorable Court, giving notice to the Defendants Melissa Snowberger and Snowberger, her husband, of Waynesboro, Pennsylvania, William Creager, unmarried, of Waynesboro, Pennsylvania, Marvin Gardiner, unmarried, of New York
