FOURTH: That the said Minnie Gouker Barnes, departed from this life, on July 3, 1953.

FIFTH: That all of the parties to this proceeding are adults.

SIXTH: That the said real estate is not susceptible to division in kind among the parties entitled thereto without great loss and damage, and it would be to the best interest and advantage of all concerned that the said property be sold under the ORDERS of your Honorable Court and the proceeds be divided among the parties thereto according to their respective interest.

TO THE END THEREFORE:

1. That a decree may be passed by your Honorable Court for the sale of the said real estate mentioned in the foregoing Bill of Complaint and the proceeds distributed under the direction of your Honorable Court to the parties according to their respective interest.

2. And that your Complainants may have such other and further relief as the nature of their case may require.

And the Complainants pray for the following process:

May it please your Honors to grant unto your Complainants the Writ of Subpoena directed to Ethel May Lloyd and Ernest Lloyd, her husband, Brunswick, Maryland, and Lawrence X. Gouker, and Mary Gouker, his wife, 417 East Patrick Street, Frederick, Maryland, commanding them to be and appear in your Honorable Court on some certain day to be named therein, and answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree that may be passed therein.
