 ADDITIONAL TESTIMONY taken before the Court. Hon. Arthur
 D. Willard, December 3, 1941.

A. HART ETCHISON, one of the Complainants, being first
 duly sworn, deposes and says:

By Mr. Schnauffer:

Q Will you please give your full name and residence?

A Arthur Hart Etchison, 106 East Church Street, Frederick.

Q What is your occupation?

A Funeral Director.

Q Are you a partner of M. R. Etchison and A. Hart Etchison,
 partners trading as M. R. Etchison and Son?

A I am.

Q As funeral director, Mr. Etchison, did you have charge
 of the body of Alice Virginia Johnson? A. I did.

Q What was your charge for the service rendered on that
 occasion? A. I buried her July 15, 1939. The bill was \$181.50.

Q Have you been paid anything?

A July 22 paid me \$75, leaving a balance of \$106.50.

Q At this time I show you a statement. Was that made up
 by your firm? A. I made it up myself and swore to it.

Q And the amount therein stated is correct? A. Correct.
 (Filed in evidence, having been previously filed with Bill)

Q Were letters of administration in the Orphans' Court ever
 taken out on the estate of Alice Virginia Johnson? A. Not to my know-
 ledge.

Q She died intestate so far as you know? A. So far as I know.

Q Did the deceased, Alice Virginia Johnson, have any personal
 property, to your knowledge? A. Not to my knowledge.
