TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

Your Petitioner, Beatrice Trail Fenton, respectfully represents unto your Honors:

That by the Will of Grace W. Trail, deceased, dated January 18, 1941, which was probated on the 4th day of October, 1941, and which is recorded in Liber R.L.L. No. 1, folio 198, one of the Will Records in the Office of the Register of Wills for Frederick County, Charles McC. Mathias and Charles B. Trail were nominated, constituted and appointed as Trustees of a trust estate therein created for the benefit of Grace Trail Babcock.

That on January 14, 1943 Charles McC. Mathias and Charles B. Trail accepted the said testamentary appointment and entered into the execution of their trust and furnished bond in accordance with the Orders made and passed by your Honorable Court.

That on January 27, 1943 your Honorable Court assumed jurisdiction of the trust so created as aforesaid by the Last Will and Testament of Grace W. Trail, deceased.

That your Petitioner is a daughter of the said Grace W. Trail, deceased, and a sister of the cestui que trust, Grace Trail Babcock, and as such has, under the terms of the aforesaid Last Will and Testament of Grace W. Trail, an interest in the said trust estate.

That on the 23th day of November, 1955 Charles McC. Mathias, one of the aforesaid Trustees, appointed to act in conjunction with Charles B. Trail in the management of the aforesaid trust estate, filed his petition in your Honorable Court stating that he was desirous to retire from and resign such trust and praying release and discharge from the further execution of said trust.
