

Honeysuckle Hill, Westminster, Maryland, under the general supervision of the said Springfield State Hospital at Sykesville, Maryland.

FOURTH: That the said Grace Trail Babcock is now, and for sometime last past has been suffering from a mental disability by reason of which she is incapable of the management of her property and estate.

FIFTH: That the said Grace Trail Babcock has been examined by Dr. Maud M. Rees and Dr. M. Virginia Beyer, medical doctors practicing in the State of Maryland for the past five years, Dr. Maud M. Rees having attended and examined the said Grace Trail Babcock within ten (10) days of the filing of this petition, and that your petitioners file herewith certificates sworn to and subscribed by the said doctors as to the cause, nature, extent and probable duration of the incompetency of the said Grace Trail Babcock, which said certificates are filed herewith and prayed to be taken and considered a part hereof and marked "Exhibit 1" and "Exhibit 2" respectively.

SIXTH: That the said Grace Trail Babcock is the owner in common with others of an undivided one-eighth interest in two certain farms situate, lying and being in Frederick County, Maryland, said interest having been devised to the said Grace Trail Babcock by virtue of the Wills of her aunts, Florence Trail and Bertha Trail, respectively.

SEVENTH: That a Bill of Complaint has been heretofore filed in your Honorable Court in No. 15215 Equity, wherein the said Grace Trail Babcock is made one of the parties defendant, and the Bill of Complaint filed in said cause prays for the sale and partition of the said two mentioned farms and a distribution of the proceeds derived therefrom under the supervision and direction of your Honorable Court, in which, as heretofore stated, the said Grace Trail Babcock has an undivided one-eighth interest.
