

(5) That the said Maude I. Harp is also possessed of certain household furniture, of undetermined value, located in the aforesaid dwelling at Mount Airy, as well as four shares of stock of Smith and Reifsnider, Inc., in the value of approximately Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00), and cash to the extent of approximately One Hundred Seventy-five (\$175.00) to Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).

(6) That the said Maude I. Harp is a patient at the Taylor Manor Hospital, in Ellicott City, Howard County, where she is now receiving hospitalization and treatment, and is indebted unto said hospital in the amount of One Thousand Eighty Six Dollars and Thirty Cents (\$1,086.30), as well as to various other persons in miscellaneous amounts.

(7) That there is no one to manage the person and estate of the said Maude I. Harp, and the contract purchasers of the aforesaid real property at Mount Airy, Carroll County, have declined to take title thereto.

TO THE END THEREFORE:

(1) That a writ de lunatico inquirendo, - - - -, be issued to inquire into the sanity of the said Maude I. Harp.

(2) That this honorable court forthwith pass such an order as may be required by Article 16, Section 135 of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

(3) That a committee or trustee be appointed to take charge of the person and estate of the said Maude I. Harp.

(4). And for such other and further relief as your petitioner's case may require.
