THIS DEED, made on this 8th day of March, in the year nine-  
 teen hundred and twenty-two, by Thomas H. Clark and Jane Clark,  
 his wife, residents of Frederick County, Maryland;-

WITNESSETH, That for and in consideration of the sum of  
ten dollars, current money, and other good and valuable consider-  
 ations paid unto us by Henry N. Waters, resident of Baltimore  
 City, Maryland, at and before the execution and delivery of this  
 Deed, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we, the said  
 Thomas H. Clark and Jane Clark, his wife, do hereby grant and  
 convey unto the said Henry N. Waters, all that lot of land situ-  
 ated lying and being in Mount Pleasant District, in Frederick  
 County, in the State of Maryland, and consisting of;-

FIRST, All that tract or parcel of land being a part of  
 "The Resurvey on Macley's Luck", beginning for the same at the  
 end of the 2nd line of John W. Burrier's lot, it being also the  
 end of the 6th. line of the whole part of said tract which was  
 lately surveyed by William H. Hilleary for 69 acres, 2 rods and  
 36 square perches and running thence with the outlines 5 courses,  
 North  $1\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  West  $55\frac{1}{2}$  perches to a stone, North  $86^{\circ}$  West  $35\frac{1}{2}$  perches,  
 South  $4.5/6^{\circ}$  West  $61.16/100$  perches, South  $31^{\circ}$  East 10 perches,  
 North  $52^{\circ}$  East  $4,71/100$  perches ending in the middle of the turn-  
 pike road, and with the middle thereof, North  $73\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  East  $14,9/10$   
 perches, North  $82\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  East  $19,26/100$  perches, then North  $1\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  West 1  
 perch to the place of beginning, containing 15 acres and 5 square  
perches of land, more or less, and being the same land conveyed by
