The above Petition as amended and Exhibits and Affidavit thereto, and the Answer of George W. Page, Bank Commissioner of Maryland, Receiver of The Central Trust Company of Maryland, to said Petition, having by the Court been read and considered, it is thereupon on this 4 day of May, in the year nineteen hundred and thirty-two, Ordered by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, sitting as a Court of Equity, and by the authority thereof that the Court hereby assumes jurisdiction of all the trust estates created by the last Will and Testament, "Exhibit E. A. L.", of Ernest A. Lawrence, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, and it is further Ordered that Edward J. Smith and C. A. Lawrence Downey, residents of Frederick County, Maryland, be and they are hereby appointed Trustees in place and stead of The Central Trust Company of Maryland, to take charge of all the trust estates and trust property and execute all the trusts named in the last Will and Testament "Exhibit E. A. L." of said Ernest A. Lawrence, with all the powers and duties and liabilities conferred by said last Will and Testament upon The Central Trust Company of Maryland, Trustee, for the benefit of all persons and corporations named in said last Will and Testament "Exhibit E. A. L.";-and it is further Ordered that before acting as said Trustees the said Edward J. Smith and C. A. Lawrence Downey, shall execute and deliver to the Clerk of the Court their duly approved bond, if a surety company, in the penalty of *sixteen* Thousand Dollars, and if a personal Bond, in the penalty of *thirty two* Thousand Dollars, *The surety on said bond to be approved by the Court or the clerk thereof,* and upon the qualification of said Trustees, it is thereupon further Ordered by the Court
