

ORDER OF COURT.

Upon the foregoing petition and affidavit of Millard G. Dutrow, and the exhibits files with said petition; it is, this 16th day of ~~August~~ ^{September}, 1958, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting in Equity, and by the authority thereof ORDERED:
