

FOURTH: That your Petitioner and the said Stephen F. George reside together in their home in Bethesda, Montgomery County, Maryland; that your Petitioner, Regina B. George and the said Regis F. George, her deceased husband, had proceeded to subdivide and established a portion of said whole parcel it being known as "Rolling Green Subidivision," a Plat of said Subdivision being recorded in Plat Book No. 3, folio 144, one of the Plat Records in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Frederick County; that several lots had been conveyed in the aforementioned subdivision and there are several lots remaining to be sold and conveyed.


FIFTH: That your Petitioner has a prospective purchaser for a parcel of said land known and designated on the aforesaid Plat as Lot 1 in Block 2, it being an unimproved parcel of land containing 33,941 square feet, at and for the purchase price of One Thousand Four Hundred Fifty (\$1,450.00) Dollars; that your Petitioner believes it to be a fair market value for said parcel of land and avers that it would be to the best interest, benefit and advantage to all parties to this proceeding and especially the minor Defendant, Stephen F. George, that the sale of said land be consummated, as well as any further sales of the land in like manner.


TO THE END, THEREFORE:
