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To the Honorable, the Judges of the Circuit  
Court for Frederick County, Maryland, sitting as a Court of Equity:

The Report of T. West Claggett, Jr., Trustee,  
appointed by a Decree of your Honorable Court passed in the above  
entitled case on July 29, 1941, to make sale of certain real es-  
tate therein mentioned, respectfully shows:

That after giving bond with security for the  
faithful performance of his trust, and after having complied with  
all the other prerequisites, as required by law and the said De-  
cree, and giving notice of the time, place, manner, and terms of  
sale by advertisements inserted in "The Blade Times," a newspaper
