Your Complainants complaining say:-

First: That Emmert C. Stottlemyer, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, was, in his lifetime, and at the time of his death, seized and possessed, in fee simple, of a certain tract or lot of land, together with improvements thereon, situate and lying in Jackson and Catoctin Election Districts, Frederick County, Maryland, to-wit:-

All that lot or parcel of ground situate and lying and being in Jackson and Catoctin Election Districts, Frederick County, Maryland, along the Public Road leading from Boonsboro, Washington County, to Wolfsville, Frederick County, said tract of land containing three (3) acres of land, more or less, and being the same property which was conveyed to the said Emmert C. Stottlemyer by deed from Harry L. Moser and Mertie E. Moser, his wife, dated the 4th day of April, A. D. 1908, and recorded in Liber S. T. H. No. 282, folio 428, among the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland, a copy of which deed is herewith filed, made a part hereof, and marked "Exhibit A".

Second: That the said Emmert C. Stottlemyer being so seized and possessed, departed this life on or about
