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TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition and Report of Sale of George W. Bittle, Trustee named in the Mortgage executed by Frank O. Lowery and Della E. Lowery, his wife, to the Myersville Savings Bank, Mortgagee, respectfully represents unto Your Honors:

1. That a certain Frank O. Lowery and Della E. Lowery, his wife, being indebted unto the Myersville Savings Bank in the sum of \$2955.00 upon their joint and several promissory note dated the 23rd day of February, in the year 1929, payable six months after date, for the purpose of securing the payment of said note at maturity or of any note that may be given from time to time thereafter as a renewal thereof or any part thereof, did on said 23rd day of February, 1929, execute and deliver to the Myersville Savings Bank a deed or mortgage granting and conveying unto the said Myersville Savings Bank all those two tracts or parcels of land situate, lying and being on the West side of Main Street in Myersville, Frederick County, Maryland; the first parcel of land being the same lot of ground which was conveyed to William M. Bittle by deed bearing date December 31, 1901 and executed by Emma T. Shank and John H. Shank, her husband, recorded in Liber D. H. H. No. 13, folio 98, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland; and the second piece or parcel of land being a strip or portion of land lying South of the aforesaid lot of land conveyed unto the said William M. Bittle by deed executed by Emma T. Shank and John H. Shank, her
