TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:-

The Complainant, S. ^{solomon} L. Allison, who sues as well for himself as for all other creditors of Sarah A. Knott, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, who will come in and contribute to the expenses of this suit, says:-

1. That the said Sarah A. Knott died intestate on or about November 27, 1939, and this Complainant, S. ^{solomon} L. Allison, furnished certain funeral services and things for and about the burial of the said Sarah A. Knott, of the value of One Hundred Ninety-five Dollars (\$195.00), and, in addition thereto, under date of April 20, 1939, this Complainant, at the specific instance and request of the said Sarah A. Knott (then a widow) and upon her promise to pay therefor, furnished certain funeral services and things for and about the burial of her husband, John Dennis Knott, itemized and sworn copies of said funeral bills respectively being filed herewith as part hereof, marked "Exhibits A. and B."

2. That the said Sarah A. Knott, at the time of her decease, was seized and possessed, in fee simple, of the land and premises, situate, lying and being in Emmitsburg Election District, Frederick County, Maryland, along or near the public road leading from Emmitsburg past "Annandale School House, as further described in the deed from J. Thomas Gelwicks to the said Sarah A. Knott, dated April 1, 1911, and
