ANSWER

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The answer of the Defendant, the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, a body corporate, respectfully represents unto this Honorable Court as follows, to wit:

1. In answering Paragraph No. 1 of said Bill of Complaint, this Defendant admits that the said Lewis H. Knock and Pauline Z. Knock were indebted unto the Commercial Bank of Maryland in the sum of Twenty-thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00), and as evidence thereof executed the two promissory notes mentioned in said bill of complaint, and delivered the same, for value received, to the said Commercial Bank of Maryland, but neither admit nor deny that the said Five Thousand Dollar (\$5,000.00) note is held, for value, by the plaintiff, and demands strict proof thereof; and further answering said paragraph, this defendant admits that the said Fifteen Thousand Dollar (\$15,000) note is held by the defendant, the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, a body corporate, organized and doing business under the Acts of Congress of the United States of America.

2. That this defendant admits that a mortgage was executed to secure the indebtedness represented by the two aforesaid promissory notes, the notes mentioned in paragraph 1 of said plaintiff's bill of complaint, conveying certain property on South Market Street in Frederick City, in Frederick County, State of Maryland, the property being described substantially the same in
