TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The petition and Report of Sales of Leslie N. Coblentz
and John E. Oxley, Trustees in the above entitled cause, respect-
fully shows unto your Honors:

(1) That pursuant to provisions of a decree of your
Honorable Court, dated May 13, 1940, the Trustees in said decree
