I give unto my niece, Viola Knill, the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000.00).

I give unto Marie Murphy, the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000.00)

I give unto Mary Hall, colored, the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

I give unto the Most Reverend Michael J. Curley, Roman Catholic Archbishop of Baltimore, and his successors, a corporation sole, the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00), to be paid by said corporation sole as follows:
