

NINTH. Answering the ninth paragraph of the Bill of Complaint, this Defendant says that according to the correct construction of the Will of Regina C. Grinder, and further according to the correct construction of the Will of Joseph S. Grinder, said Testatrix and said Testator devised the dwelling house property mentioned in the Bill of Complaint to this Defendant for and during the time of the natural life of this Defendant, the title to said dwelling house property to vest in this Defendant at the time of the death of the said Marie Murphy.

TENTH. Further answering said Bill of Complaint, this Defendant consents to a Decree to be passed by your Honorable Court for the sale of the real estate mentioned in said Bill of Complaint by trustees to be appointed by your Honorable Court.

ELEVENTH. And further answering said Bill of Complaint this Defendant consents that your Honorable Court will take jurisdiction in the premises and construe the true legal meaning of the residuary clause and all other clauses of the last will and Testament of the said Regina C. Grinder, deceased, and also the true legal meaning of the residuary clause and all other clauses of the last Will and Testament of Joseph S. Grinder, deceased, relative said real estate.
