TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The bill of complaint of Ella Whitter, May Schaff, Lee Schaff and Lena Schaff, respectfully represents:

1. That Hiram J. Smith, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, departed this life, testate, in the year 1906, leaving a last will and testament in which he devised, amongst other things, the residue of his estate to be divided, share and share alike, amongst his children, Ella, Addie, Vernon and May; that portion falling to Vernon and May, wife of Richard Schaff, to be held in trust for the benefit of their children at their death, as appears by reference to a certified copy of said will, filed herewith and marked "Exhibit A", to be taken as part of this bill of complaint.
