PETITION FOR DECREE PRO CONFESSO

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of Carroll H. Sigafoose, by C. Clifton Virts, his solicitor, respectfully shows unto Your Honors:

FIRST: That on or about the 26th day of July, 1961, your Petitioner filed his Bill of Complaint herein and on the same day an order was entered herein directing that your Petitioner, by causing a copy of such order to be inserted in some newspaper published in Frederick County, Maryland, once a week, in each of four successive weeks, the last of such publications to be made not less than thirty days before the 3rd day of October, 1961, give notice to the unknown heirs, devisees, personal representatives, descendants or successors of Frank Nichols, deceased, whether they be residents or non-residents of this State, of the substance and object of said Bill of Complaint and warning them to appear in this Court in person or by solicitor, on or before 3rd day of October, 1961, next to show cause, if any they have, why a decree ought not be passed as prayed.

SECOND: That such notice was duly published in the Emmitsburg Chronicle, a newspaper published in Frederick County, Maryland, as appears from the printers certificate filed herewith.

THIRD: That the unknown heirs, devisees, personal representatives, descendants or successors of Frank Nichols, deceased, have failed to appear or answer said Bill of Complaint or show cause why a decree ought not to be passed as prayed although the time
