This Deed made this 5th day of April in the year Nineteen Hundred and Sixteen by Hannah Lewis and David Lewis her husband of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth: That in consideration of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) the said Hannah Lewis and David Lewis do grant unto David O. Lewis of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, all of the following described parcels of land except about 2½ acres of land more or less which was sold off on the Eastern side of first parcel by said David Lewis to Theodore Smith, Said parcel of land being parts of several original tracts of land called "The Resurvey on Israel's lot", "I'll See Whose the Land Will Be", "Frey's Good Will", "Creeger's Scheme", being contained in the following metes and bounds, Beginning for 1sr. parcel at the beginning of a deed dated April 4, 1857 from Wm. D. Brown and wife to David Lewis for 42 146/160 acres more or less and running thence N. 31° E. 41 perches, N. 69° E. 40 ps. S. 61° E. 76 ps. S. 47 ps. N. 73° W. 106½ ps. N. 89° W. 23½ ps. then with a straight line to the place of beginning, containing 42 acres and 146 perches of land more or less.

Beginning for the second parcel at the beginning of Deed dated Nov. 24, 1873 from John Fessler and wife to David Lewis for 23 55/160 acres of land more or less and running thence or is bounded on the South by the land of Bernard Lewis, on the east by land of Levi Buhrman and on the North by land of Ephraim Buhrman, containing 23 55/160 acres of land, more or less.
