TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT.

The Petition of H. Lee Wolf and Ida V. Wolf, his wife, complainants in the above-entitled cause, respectfully shows unto Your Honors:

1. That on the seventh day of July, nineteen hundred and thirty-eight, they filed their Bill of Complaint in the above-entitled cause praying that a decree be passed for the sale of the real estate described therein by a trustee or trustees to be appointed by your Honorable Court, and that said proceeds of sale may be divided among the parties entitled thereto according to their respective right and interest under the direction of your Honorable Court.

Recher and John L. Recher are defendants in this cause.

TO THE END, THEREFORE:

1. That the said The Thurmont Bank, a body corporate, may be made a party defendant in this cause, as provided by Section 152 of Article 16 of the Annotated Code of Public General Laws of the State of Maryland.

And your petitioners pray that the Writ of Subpoena be issued directed to The Thurmont Bank, a body corporate, Thurmont, Frederick County, Maryland, commanding it to be and appear in your
