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Susan C. Mumford, Amanda F. Cochran, Lydia M. Rohrback, and Samuel Butts and Paul Butts, children of Addie Butts, a sister, and Samuel Curtis Butts, her husband, all of whom reside in Frederick County, Maryland.

3. That the said James B. Cochran, Susan C. Mumford and John W. Mumford, her husband, Amanda F. Cochran, Lydia M. Rohrback, and James B. Cochran, acting for and on behalf of Samuel Butts and Paul Butts, infants, have contracted for the sale of the said land mentioned in Exhibits "A" and "B" of which the said Mary Jane Cochran died seized and possessed, together with the rights, ways, privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining, to Z. Carlton Cochran at and for the sum of \$140.00, as will appear by an acknowledgment of purchase signed by the said purchaser, which is filed herewith as a part hereof marked Exhibit "C".

4. That the said sale made as hereinbefore set forth is an advantageous one, and it would be to the interest and advantage of the said infants and all parties having an interest in said land if the said sale would be ratified and confirmed by your Honorable Court and a Trustee appointed to convey the said land to the said purchaser thereof clear and discharged of all liens and encumbrances thereon, and the proceeds of said sale equally distributed to the parties legally entitled to receive the same.

TO THE END, THEREFORE,

(1) That said sale may be ratified and confirmed by your Honorable Court.

(2) That a trustee may be appointed to convey all the interests of the parties to this cause in and to the land sold as aforesaid to the purchaser thereof clear and discharged of all encumbrances thereon.
