The object of these proceedings is to obtain a Decree for the sale of the real estate of Andrew J. Wolf, deceased, and the distribution of the proceeds therefrom among his widow and heirs at law.

The Bill and amendment thereto states that the said Andrew J. Wolf died on the 29th, day of October A.D. 1921, seized and possessed of certain real estate situated in Frederick County, Maryland, to-wit: One lot with improvements thereon at Ladiesburg, Maryland, containing about Six acres of land more or less, and a mountain lot in said county containing about Eighteen acres more or less.

That said real estate is not susceptible of partition among those entitled without great loss and injury.

That the heirs at law of the said Andrew J. Wolf, deceased, are Lula Wolf, (widow) who is now pregnant by the said Andrew J. Wolfe, deceased, and the following children by a former wife <sup>whom</sup> from the said Andrew J. Wolf has been divorced, viz: Phillip L. Wolf, adult, whose wife is Sherdie E. Wolf, Alvey S. Wolf, adult, Mary Misner whose husband is Victor Misner, Violet Green, whose husband is Rex Green, Keller Wolf, infant and Charles C. Wolf, infant, all of whom reside in Maryland, and Alice Wolf, infant, who resides at Carlisle, Pennsylvania.

The Bill prays for a decree to be passed for the sale of said real estate and a distribution of the proceeds among those entitled according to their respective interest there in, and for a Trustee to be appointed for said purposes and for other relief.
