To the Honorable, the Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity.

The bill of complaint of Jane G. Padgett, widow of Robert H. Padgett, deceased, respectively represents unto your Honors.

First, That Robert H. Padgett, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, departed this life on the 17th day of April in the year 1920, intestate and at the time of his death was seized and possessed of two lots or parcels of land situate, lying and being in the village of Adamstown, Frederick County, Maryland, to-wit:-

(a) All that lot or parcel of land containing 91 1/4 square perches of land and being the same lot or parcel of land which was conveyed by the Franklin Saving Bank of Frederick to the said Robert H. Padgett by deed dated the 22nd day of October in the year 1900, and recorded in Liber D. H. H. No. 7, folio 369 one of the Land Records of Frederick County, except therefrom however all that part of the aforesaid lot containing 71 1/2 square perches of land more or less, conveyed by the said Robert H. Padgett and Janie B. Padgett, his wife, to George Leicester Thomas by deed dated the 15th day of November in the year 1905 and recorded in Liber S. T. H. No. 271 folio 396 one of the said Land Records.

(b) Also all that part or parcel of land which was conveyed to the said Robert H. Padgett by Eleanor E. White and Walter Wails White,
