


Agent" (now deceased), sold by Charlotte W. Yarroll, Treasurer of Frederick County, Collector of State and County Taxes for Frederick County, said sale having been made on April 10, 1961, to A. Earl Shipley, of Carroll County, Maryland, who thereafter, on April 11, 1961, did duly transfer and assign Certificate of Sale No. 176 issued by said Charlotte W. Yarroll, Collector as aforesaid, unto Lehigh Portland Cement Company, a body corporate, the plaintiff in this proceeding.

The bill states, among other things, that the amounts necessary for redemption have not been paid, although more than a year and a day from the date of sale has expired.

It is thereupon, this 15th day of June, 1962, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Sitting in Equity, ORDERED, that notice be given by the insertion of a copy of this Order in some newspaper having a general circulation in Frederick County, Maryland, once a week for four successive weeks, warning all persons interested in the said property to be and appear in this Court by the 21st day of August, 1962, and redeem the property as hereinabove described, and answer the bill or thereafter a final decree will be rendered foreclosing all rights of redemption in the property, and vesting in the plaintiff a title, free and clear of all encumbrances.
