TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR FREDERICK COUNTY,
SITTING AS A COURT OF EQUITY:

The Bill of Complaint of George Wallace Davis, Jr., Trustee under the Last Will and Testament of George Wallace Davis, Sr., deceased, George Wallace Davis, Jr., individually, and Virginia B. Davis, his wife, George Wallace Davis 3d and Barbara S. Davis, his wife, Ann D. Knapp and Edgar I. Knapp, her husband, Harold W. Davis and Grace Davis, his wife, Robert H. Harris, widower, Robert H. Harris, Jr. and Constance Harris, his wife, Sherwyn L. Davis and Kathryn B. Davis, his wife, Mary Ann Miner and C. Douglas Miner, Jr., her husband, and Kathryn D. Mattimore and Peter M. Mattimore, her husband, respectfully shows unto your Honors:

FIRST: That George Wallace Davis, late of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, died on or about the 7th day of May, in the year 1941, seized and possessed of certain lands in Urbana District, Frederick County, State of Maryland, containing approximately 263 acres, more or less, of farm land and an undivided one-half interest in and to 47 acres of mountain land, more particularly described as follows:

(a) All that farm situate, lying and being in Urbana District, Frederick County, State of Maryland, containing 134 acres, 3 roods and 11 square perches of land, more or less, and also one undivided half of a mountain lot containing 47 acres of mountain land, as more particularly described in the following deeds to the said George Wallace Davis:

(1) From Charles W. Ross, Jr., bearing date on the 11th day of September, 1920, and recorded in Liber No. 333, Folio 446, a certified copy of which is herewith filed and marked Exhibit No. 1 and prayed to be taken as part hereof together with all other exhibits herewith filed;

(2) From Vernon W. Davis and Ethel L. Davis, his wife, bearing date on the 8th day of January, 1921, and recorded in Liber No. 333, Folio 535, a certified copy of which is herewith filed and marked Exhibit No. 2;
