TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR
FREDERICK COUNTY, SITTING AS A COURT OF EQUITY:

The Petition and Report of Sale of George Wallace Davis, Jr.,
Trustee in the above entitled cause, respectfully shows unto your
Honors:

FIRST: That by virtue of a decree of your Honorable Court,
passed in the above entitled cause on the 29th day of January, 1962,
your Trustee filed his bond in the Clerk's Office of this Court, as
provided by the said decree, and your said Trustee further reports
to your Honorable Court that your Petitioner, acting as Trustee under
the Last Will and Testament of George Wallace Davis, deceased, entered
into a contract of sale with Harry C. Burdette and Myrtle Irene Burdette,
his wife, bearing date on the 14th day of April, in the year 1960, in
which said contract your said Petitioner and Trustee agreed to sell to
the said Harry C. Burdette and Myrtle Irene Burdette, his wife, all
those lots, pieces or parcels of land containing approximately 263
acres, more or less, situate, lying and being in Frederick County, State
of Maryland, of which the said George Wallace Davis died seized and
possessed, and which by his Last Will and Testament bearing date on
the 15th day of December, 1939 and admitted to probate and filed for
record in the Office of the Register of Wills of the County of Phila-
delphia, in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, on the 13th day of May,
1941, and recorded in Wills Book No. 232, Folio 354, etc., a certified
copy of which is recorded in the Office of the Register of Wills of
Frederick County, Maryland, in Liber R.L.L. No. 1, Folio 267, were de-
vised to the said George Wallace Davis, Jr. as Trustee, at and for the
sum of \$85,000.00, of which said sum \$4,250.00 was paid simultaneously
