BILL OF COMPLAINT FOR THE SALE OF
REAL ESTATE UNDER SECTION 157 OF ARTICLE
16 OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Bill of Complaint of Francis M. Manahan and Paul
C. Fry, Administrators of the Goods and Chattels of Alvin A.
Anderson, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, respect-
fully shows unto Your Honors:

FIRST: That the said Alvin A. Anderson died on Decem-
ber 26, 1960, intestate, being possessed of insufficient personal
property to pay his debts, but seized of a lot of land situate on
the northerly side of Main Street in Sabillasville, Hauvers
District, Frederick County, State of Maryland, fronting on said
Street 108 feet, more or less, with a depth of 220 feet, more
or less, to an alley being adjacent to St. Mark's Lutheran Church
on the west and an alley on the east, being part of Lot No. 37
and all of Lot No. 38 as shown on the Plat of Sabillasville, and
being the same real estate that was conveyed to Paul C. Fry et
al., Committee for Alvin A. Anderson, an incompetent, in No.
17,299 Equity in the Circuit Court for Frederick County, by deed
dated June 5, 1952, from Albert C. Smith, et ux. and recorded
in Liber 503, folio 292, one of the Land Records of Frederick
