




their heirs and assigns, all that piece or parcel of real estate
containing sixteen (16) acres more or less, situate lying and
being in Lewistown District, Frederick County, Maryland, and
being the same property that was conveyed by Foster H. Blick-
enstaff and Matilda V. Blickenstaff, his wife, by deed of even
date herewith intended to be recorded just prior to or simul-
taneously with this deed among the land records of Frederick
County.

Together with all the improvements thereon and all the
rights ways, easements, and appurtenances thereunto belonging
or in anywise appertaining.
