A That is correct.

Q What is this document?

A That is a deed I got back that I bought a piece of this land back from my brother that I had sold him in the first place.

Q This piece of land you bought back from your brother - who owns that property?

A That is the property I am on now.

Q. The property you own now?

A Yes.

Q Which you are on, you say?

A Yes.

Q This is the parcel which we are trying to straighten out the title to by these proceedings today?

A That is correct.
