TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Bill of Complaint of Alvey R. Wolfe, Orpha M. Eccard, Raymond T. Wolfe, Earl D. Wolfe, Willie C. Wolfe, Charles A. Wolfe, Nellie V. Hildebrand, Olive E. Blickenstaff, Ethel R. Gross, Elvin R. Wolfe, and Daniel L. Wolfe, Plaintiffs herein, respectfully shows unto your Honors:

(1) That Albert C. Wolfe, late of Frederick County, Maryland, departed this life on or about the 14th day of January, 1962, seized and possessed of a small rural estate situate along Whistman Lane about one mile north of Harmony, in Jackson Election District, Frederick County, Maryland, containing 9 acres, 3 roods and 39 $\frac{1}{2}$ square perches of land, more or less, improved with a 6-room log house, bank barn, hog pen and other outbuildings; being part of the same real estate which was conveyed unto the decedent herein (1) by deed from Jerome E. Gaver, et. ux., to Albert C. Wolfe and Ida Wolfe, his wife, dated March 31, 1903, and recorded in Liber No. 320, folio 514, one of the Land Records of the County aforesaid, (the said Ida Wolfe having predeceased the said Albert C. Wolfe); EXCEPTING AND RESERVING THEREOUT AND THEREFROM all that piece or parcel of land conveyed in (2) a deed from Albert C. Wolfe, widower, to Earl D. Wolfe, et. ux., dated June 10, 1961, and recorded in Liber No. 655, folio 192, one of the Land Records of the County aforesaid, certified copies of which aforesaid deeds are filed herewith as "Exhibits Nos. 1 and 2", respectively, and which are prayed may be taken and considered a part hereof.
