THIRD: That the said property herein above referred to has not been redeemed by any party in interest, although more than one year from the date of sale on April 10, 1961, has expired.




TO THE END THEREFORE:


1. That a final Decree may be passed by your Honorable Court, foreclosing all rights of redemption of the Defendants herein, in and to the property herein referred to, and that the County Treasurer for Frederick County, Maryland, be directed to prepare and execute a deed, in fee simple, unto Bernard H. Boyle and Mary E. Boyle, his wife, the Complainants herein upon the payment by them in full, the purchase money of the property together with all taxes, interest and penalties thereon accruing subsequent to the date of sale.
