

unto Edgar R. Young, so long as he shall live, and at the death of the said Edgar R. Young, I direct that this trust shall cease and the corpus of said fund I give and bequeath unto the children of D. Vincent Beachley and Alma Beachley, his wife, born unto them during their present marriage, share and share alike, or to their respective heirs at law, per stirpes, and in the event, at the termination of the above trust, that there should not be living any children born to the said D. Vincent Beachley and Alma Beachley, his wife, during their present marriage, nor children of any such children, then in such case I give and bequeath the corpus of said trust fund unto the heirs at law, per stirpes, of my Grand-father John Young and Grand-father George Karn, equally.

FIFTH;- I give and bequeath unto D. Vincent Beachley and Edgar R. Young, and their successor in the trust the sum of One Thousand Dollars, in trust nevertheless that they will invest the said sum, and pay the income arising therefrom unto Mrs. Estey Ahalt, wife of Lester R. Ahalt, so long as she shall live, and at the death of the said Estey Ahalt, I direct that this trust shall cease, and I give and bequeath the corpus of said trust fund unto the children of the said Estey Ahalt, share and share alike, or to their respective heirs at law.

SIXTH;- All the rest and residue of my estate, I give, devise and bequeath unto D. Vincent Beachley and Edgar R. Young, share and share alike.

SEVENTH;- I further declare and provide that, in case any devise, legacy or bequest herein contained should fail to take effect for any reason whatsoever, then, and in such event I give, devise and bequeath the said property of whatsoever nature it may be intended by this my last will and testament to have been devised, given or bequeathed, and which said devise, legacy or bequest may fail to take effect, for any reason as aforesaid, equally to the heirs at law, per stirpes, of my Grand-father John Young and my Grand-father George Karn.

Eighth;- I constitute and appoint D. Vincent Beachley and Edgar R. Young to be the Executors of this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all other wills and codicils by me heretofore made.
