THIS DEED, Made this 5th day of January, A.D., 1939, by Charles R. Stup, (widower), of Baltimore City, Maryland, but now temporarily in Frederick County, Maryland.

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00), and other good and valuable considerations, the receipt of all which is hereby acknowledged, I, the said Charles R. Stup, (widower), of Baltimore City, Maryland, but now temporarily in Frederick County, Maryland, do hereby grant and convey unto Charles E. Bruchey, unmarried, of Frederick County, Maryland, all those tracts or parcels of land in Frederick County, Maryland, more particularly described as follows:-

The property hereby intended to be conveyed is part of the same property which was conveyed to Charles R. Stup and wife, by Milton G. Urner, Jr. by deed dated April 22, 1936, and recorded among the Land Records of Frederick County in Liber 402, folio 7, it also being parts of the same tracts or parcels of land which were devised unto the said Charles R. Stup by the last Will and Testament of Howard M. Stup (deceased) as recorded in Liber M.F. S. No. 1, folio 560, one of the records in the Register of Wills Office for Frederick County, Maryland, it being all the part or parts of said land now belonging to said Charles R. Stup lying north and northeast of the Right of Way of the New Dual Highway leading from Frederick to Hagerstown where the same crosses the property of said Charles R. Stup as described in the deed from said Charles R. Stup to the State roads commission of Maryland dated January 31, 1938, and recorded in Liber 411, folio 256, and is described in three parcels:-
