4. That by a deed dated \_\_\_\_\_ January, 1962, acknowledged January 23, 1962, recorded January 24, 1962, Liber 664, folio 39, Wallace E. Norris and Pauline C. Norris, his wife, conveyed the subject property to your petitioners.

5. That on or about March 14, 1962, Wallace E. Norris and Pauline C. Norris, his wife, filed separate petitions in the United States District Court, Baltimore, Maryland, asking to be adjudicated bankrupts.

6. That Wallace E. Norris and Pauline C. Norris, his wife, defaulted in the payments required under their mortgage to The First National Bank of Mount Airy, and that thereafter L. Pearce Bowlus, Attorney named in mortgage, foreclosed said mortgage and that this Honorable Court ratified and confirmed said sale on the 26th day of October, 1962.

7. That it appears that the price realized from the sale of the property will be sufficient to pay the first mortgagee, all costs of foreclosure and the second mortgagee, leaving a balance in the hands of the foreclosure attorney; that your petitioners, owners of record of the subject property pray the court to pass an order directing the auditor to distribute unto them, the fund remaining after the payment of both mortgages and foreclosure costs.
