

ORDER

Upon the foregoing Petition and Affidavit, it is this *3rd* day of November, 1961, by the Circuit Court for Baltimore County In Equity, ORDERED:

1) That Lillian Leakins be and she is hereby appointed Guardian of Michael Joseph Sponseller, infant, born on April 8, 1942, but before she shall proceed to act as said Guardian she shall file with the Clerk of this Court an approved bond in the penalty of *One Thousand* Dollars, conditioned upon the faithful performance of her duties as Guardian.

And it is further ORDERED:

2) That as prayed in the foregoing Petition that the said Lillian Leakins, Guardian of Michael Joseph Sponseller, infant, be and she is hereby authorized and empowered to execute a promissory note or such papers as may be necessary to effectuate a loan or advance from the Farmers and Mechanics-Citizens National Bank of Frederick, Maryland, in the sum of Three Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$3,300.00), so that the proceeds of said loan or advance may be used to purchase the Towson Welding Service for the use and benefit of Michael Joseph Sponseller, infant.
