TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:*

The Petition of William H. Hiltner and Charles A. Six, Committee of Georgeanna Brust, respectfully represents:-

1. That by an order of this Court, passed on the 3rd day of March, 1914, in this cause, they were appointed committee of the person and estate of the said Georgeanna Brust, lunatic, and they have filed their duly approved bond with the clerk of said Court.
2. That the said lunatic is now about seventy years of age and the only property and assets she has consist of a house and lot situated on the South Side of West South Street, in Frederick City, Maryland, some household furniture and effects, and about \$185.00 in Bank, as shown by the return of the Inquisition, in the above case.
3. That the property belonging to said lunatic particularly the real estate as aforesaid, is unoccupied, and is badly in need of repairs, and to make the necessary repairs would cost approximately \$300.00, and said property is only worth at best \$1200.00.
4. That the said Georgeanna Brust, is now living with her son, Charles A. Six, one of your Petitioners, and all of her sons and daughters have filed a paper in this cause agreeing that will give her a home, provide for, maintain and nurse her, if need be, during her lifetime, free of charge, so that there is no reason that said house and lot should remain unsold.
5. That, on the other hand, it is very important and will be to the best interest and advantage of said lunatic, as well as to the interest and advantage of her estate and all the parties
