

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner prays:

1. That said infant may again be summoned to appear in these proceedings, said infant having in the meantime married and being now Susan V. Grove Mitts, residing at 21 S. Jefferson Street, Frederick, Maryland.

2. That your Honorable Court may appoint a Guardian At Litem to appear for said infant, Susan V. Grove Mitts.

3. That your Honors may set these proceedings for hearing and examination to determine whether or not said sale was fairly and bona fide made and that at the date of said decree it was for the benefit and advantage of said infant to sell or for her interest in said real estate to be sold.

4. That your Honors may confirm said sale and all proceedings had in pursuance of and conformity to the previous orders and decrees filed herein.

5. And for such other and further relief as the nature of the case may require.
