

and did retain the proceeds thereof without any accounting to your respondents; that she did further assume the management and control of said real estate and did retain the rents and profits therefrom without any accounting to your respondents; that the said complainant, Edna J. Bomberger, before any distribution of the net proceeds of sale of the property herein, should be required to account for the proceeds of sale of said personal property and for the rents and profits from said real estate so that a proper distribution can be made to all of the heirs of Charles R. Reed and Rosie L. Reed, deceased.

WHEREFORE, having fully answered, your respondents pray that they may be hence dismissed with their proper costs.
