My father sold a small portion of this lot, containing 30 square perches of land, to my brother, Charles Maynard Reed, in October 1946. There was more than three acres left in the Birely tract after the sale to my brother.

Q. Did your father acquire another piece of land?

A. Yes, he bought a tract of woodland containing 21 acres, more or less, from William J. Stoner, and others, in 1909.

I had this deed among papers that I kept after my father's death, and I understand that it has been recently recorded.

Q. Mrs. Bomberger, you say that your father died in 1949, did he leave a Will or did he die intestate?

A. He did not leave a Will.

Q. At the time of his death, who were his heirs?

A. My mother, Rosie L. Reed, survived him and lived for a year after his death. I am the oldest daughter and am married to J. Morgan Bomberger, and live in Waynesboro, Pennsylvania. There was also a daughter, Carrie, who married Claude Yingling and now lives at 245 Cleveland Avenue in Waynesboro, Pennsylvania. There was also a son, Charles Maynard Reed, who lives at Route #1, Thurmont, Maryland, whose wife's name is Pauline Rebecca Reed. There was another daughter, Louise, who married Boyd Morrow and they live at 6313 North 28th Street, in Arlington, Virginia. There was also an afflicted daughter, whose name is Margaret Reed. She has been a hopeless invalid all of her life, and I have taken care of her since her mother died. She is living at my home in Waynesboro, Pennsylvania.
