

AMELIA L. WEINBERG, Complainant, being first duly sworn,  
deposes and says:

By Mr. Clapp:

We would like to introduce into evidence the Exhibit filed with the Bill of Complaint - Exhibit No. 1 - dated the 12th day of February, 1936, from Esther Sutro Weinberg, being a certified copy of deed dated on that date, to Leo Weinberg, L. Rae Weinberg, Leah Frances Berger, Amelia L. Weinberg and Esther Sutro Weinberg, as joint tenants, recorded in Liber 401, folio 304, one of the Land Records of Frederick County.

Also Complainant's Exhibit No. 2, filed with the bill of complaint, being deed dated the 28th day of February, 1946, by and between Esther Sutro Weinberg, unmarried, and Farmers and Mechanics National Bank of Frederick County, as Trustee, and recorded in Liber 452, folio 308, one of the Land Records of Frederick County.

Q Will you state your full name, please?

A Amelia Lowenstein Weinberg.

Q Where do you live, Miss Weinberg?

Q 1832 Biltmore Street, N. W., Washington 9, D. C.

Q You are one of the daughters of Mr. Leo Weinberg?

A I am.

Q And are you also one of the grantees named in Complainant's Exhibit No. 1, previously introduced, being the deed dated February 12, 1936, recorded in Liber 401, folio 304?

A I am.

Q Miss Weinberg, is your father, Leo Weinberg, living or dead?

A He is dead.

Q What was the date of his death?

A September 17, 1942, in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

Q And is your sister Leah Frances Berger - was she your sister?
