PETITION AND REPORT OF SALE

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition and Report of Robert E. Clapp, Jr. and H. Reese Shoemaker, Jr., Trustees in the above entitled cause respectfully shows unto your Honors:

1. That under an order of your Honorable Court dated the 31st day of October, 1963, your Petitioners were authorized to sell the property mentioned in these proceedings at private sale, by obtaining sealed bids or otherwise, as more fully set forth in the foregoing order.

2. That pursuant to such order your Petitioners did advertise that they would receive sealed bids for such property at their offices, 117 N.
