Order Of Publication

The object of this proceeding is
to foreclose all rights of redemption
of the Defendants in and to a prop-
erty assessed to Henry Howard Ahalt
in Middletown Election District,
Frederick County, Maryland, con-
taining 10 $\frac{1}{4}$ acres, more or less. The
Bill states in substance that Char-
lotte W. Yarroll, County Treasurer
for Frederick County, State of Mary-
land, offered at public auction the
real estate assessed to the said Henry
Howard Ahalt in Middletown Elec-
tion District, Frederick County,
Maryland, and that said real estate
is now vested in H. Earl Ahalt as
the only child and heir at law of
Henry Howard Ahalt deceased, and
any other persons having or claiming
to have any interest in said property.
That said sale was held on April 9,
1962 and the purchaser was Earle D.
Hightower, at the sum of Seven
Hundred Dollars (\$700.00). That said
sale was made in satisfaction of un-
paid taxes due and owing the State
of Maryland and Frederick County
for the year 1961. That the pur-
chaser paid the sum of Twelve Dol-
lars and Thirty-one Cents (\$12.31)
toward the purchase of said real es-
tate, and that the sum of Seventeen
Dollars and Forty-eight Cents (\$17.-
48), including taxes, interest and
costs, necessary to redeem the prop-
erty, has not been paid and the
property not redeemed although one
year from the date of sale has passed,
and that a final Decree is prayed for,
foreclosing all rights of redemption
of the Defendants in and to the
property assessed to Henry Howard
Ahalt.

It is thereupon, this 17th day of
June 1963, by the Circuit Court for
Frederick County, in Equity, OR-
DERED that the Plaintiff cause a
copy of this Order of Publication to
be published for at least 4 succes-
sive weeks prior to the 21st day of
August, 1963, in some newspaper
published in Frederick County,
Maryland, giving notice to the non-
resident Defendants, H. Earl Ahalt
and Helen M. Ahalt, his wife, and
to all persons having or claiming
to have any interest in the property,
of the object and substance of the
Bill of Complaint and warning them
to be and appear in this Court either
in person or by solicitor on or before
the 21st day of August, 1963, to show
cause, if any they have, why the
relief sought should not be granted.
