TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

Your Complainants, who sue for themselves as for all other
creditors of Philip I. Fisher, late of Frederick County, Maryland, de-
ceased, who shall come in and contribute to the expense of this proceed-
ing, complaining, say:

(1) That Philip I. Fisher, unmarried, late of Frederick County,
Maryland, deceased, died seized and possessed of the following described
real estate, to-wit:

All those two contiguous lots or parcels of land situate
in Jackson Election District, Frederick County, Maryland, con-
taining 4 acres, 1 rood and 12 square perches of land, more
or less, with improvements of doubtful value, the same having
been appraised in the course of the administration of the
estate of the said decedent in the Orphans Court for Frederick
County, Maryland, at a value of Four Hundred Fifty Dollars
(\$450.00), as will more fully appear by reference to a certified
copy of the Inventory of Real Estate filed in the Estate of the
said decedent as aforesaid, filed herewith as "Exhibit No. 1",
and by reference made a part hereof.

And being also the same real estate conveyed in a deed from
Elmira F. Fisher, widow, to the said Philip I. Fisher,
dated August 28, 1920, and recorded in Liber No. 342, folio 544,
one of the Land Records of the County aforesaid, wherein the
Grantor in said deed reserved an estate for her life, which
terminated by the death of the said Grantor on the 5th day
of November, 1937, a certified copy of which said deed is
filed herewith as "Exhibit No. 2" and prayed may be considered a
part hereof.
