

benefit and advantage to the Incompetent to have the Contract of Sale entered into by your Petitioner, individually, and as Committee for the Incompetent, dated May 16, 1963, ratified by your honorable Court.

EIGHTH: That upon presenting satisfactory proof of the aforementioned advances and loans made for the benefit and care of the Incompetent, that your honorable Court will pass an Order directing the Committee to make such repayments and reimbursements as aforementioned.

NINTH: That the Petition for the appointment and preparation of the necessary papers and exhibits thereto and all subsequent proceedings in this cause were prepared by W. Jerome Offutt, Esq., a member of the Frederick County Bar Association, and the future proceedings will require his services; that at various times it was necessary to seek advice in the conduct of the affairs of the Incompetent and your Petitioner is desirous of obtaining the authority of your honorable Court to retain the said W. Jerome Offutt, Esq., as her legal counsel to advise her in the administration of the estate.

TO THE END, THEREFORE:

1. That your Honorable Court will consider the said Contract of Sale for the purchase of the real estate herein administered under these proceedings and may ratify and confirm said Contract of Sale of the said real estate to Yellow Springs Lyon's Cub, Inc., a body corporate, as aforesaid, as prayed herein.

2. That your Petitioner as Committee may be authorized to convey the interest of the Incompetent in said real estate to the purchaser, Yellow Springs Lyon's Cub, Inc., a body corporate, upon payment of the full purchase price.

3. That your Petitioner, may be authorized to repay and satisfy the indebtedness incurred for the use and benefit of the Incompetent, as prayed herein.

4. That your Honorable Court will pass an Order authorizing your Petitioner to retain W. Jerome Offutt, Esq., as her counsel in these proceedings.
