The Bill of Complaint of Eleanor W. Wenner, (Bissett), by William W. Wenner, her Solicitor, respectfully represents unto your Honors:

1. That on the 10th day of April, 1961, Charlotte W. Yarroll, County Treasurer and collector of taxes for Frederick County, State of Maryland, sold unto Eleanor W. Wenner, (now Bissett) at public auction for the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) and Eighty Dollars (\$80) respectively, two parcels of land, as follows:

Lot containing 9 acres of land, more or less, located between the Canal and River and a lot 100 feet by 125 feet, more or less, with improvements, located on West Potomac Street, in Brunswick Election District, Frederick County, Maryland, assessed in the name of Roy B.
