Mt. Pleasant Election District, Frederick County, Maryland, and being known and designated as three acres, more or less, on Water Street Road, unimproved. The Bill states in substance that Charlotte W. Yarroll, County Treasurer for Frederick County, State of Maryland, offered at public auction the real estate assessed to the aforesaid Josiah Crum, in the Mt. Pleasant Election District, Frederick County, Maryland, as aforesaid, and that said real estate is now vested in the heirs of the said Josiah Crum, said heirs being Edith Hummer, Grayson Haifleigh, Ralph Haifleigh, Catherine Hahn, Mary Loy, Raymond Crum, Hallie Trout, and Martha Ellen Bill, and any other person or persons having or claiming interest in said property. That said sale was held on April 8, 1963, and that the purchaser was Charles H. Kehne, at and for the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00). That the sale was made in satisfaction of unpaid taxes due and owing the State of Maryland and Frederick County for the year 1962. That the Purchaser paid the sum of Thirteen Dollars and Thirty-three Cents (\$13.33) towards the purchase of said parcel of real estate; that the taxes, interest and costs, necessary to redeem the property have not been paid and the property not redeemed although one year and one day from the date of said sale has passed, and that a Final Decree is prayed foreclosing all rights of redemption of the respondents in and to the said property assessed to the said Josiah Crum.

It is thereupon, this 17th day of July, 1964, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, sitting as a Court of Equity, and by the Authority thereof, ORDERED that the Complainant, by causing a copy of this Order of Publication to be published for at least four successive weeks prior to the 2nd day of August, 1964, in some newspaper published in Frederick County, Maryland, giving notice to any non-resident respondent, known or unknown, and to all other persons having or claiming to have any interest in the property, of the object and substance of this Bill of Complaint, and warning them to be and appear in this court, either in person or by Solicitor, on or before the 2nd day of September, 1964, to show cause if any they have, why the relief sought should not be granted.
