ANSWER TO BILL OF COMPLAINT

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Answer of Carl A. Boller, Jr., and Virginia Boller, his wife, Elizabeth Hahn and Charles H. Hahn, her husband, and Pauline B. Ward and ~~Delbert Ward, her husband~~, to the Bill of Complaint filed against them in this cause, respectfully represents unto your Honorable Court:

FIRST: That they admit the allegations contained in the first and second paragraphs of said Bill of Complaint.

SECOND: That the Respondents deny generally the allegations contained in the third paragraph of said Bill of Complaint; further answering the third paragraph of said Bill of Complaint, your Respondents state that the buildings and improvements located on the real estate are not constantly depreciating in value but need proper coatings of paint on the exterior of said buildings and improvements.
